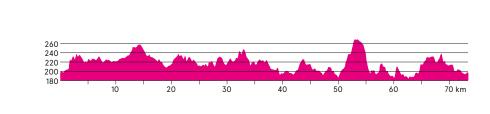

On this route, you'll hit the wall immediately! The epic Skarpabacken is demanding but, once you're done, you'll get to enjoy winding dirt roads high above Gränna. You can swim in Bunnsjö before you head back towards town. Be sure to stop at Ravelsmark Cafe or The Coffee Cottage (Kaffestugan) on Gränna Mountain.

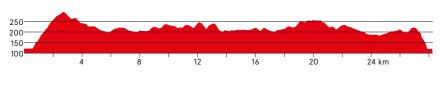

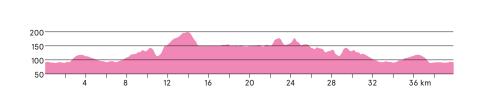

Loop around Landsjön

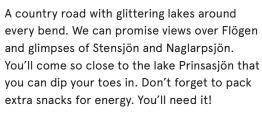

Continue on towards Kaxholmen and Äppledalen, you'll uncover epic country roads passing by vineyards and apple orchards. Ask Ingo at Gårdsrosteriet (The Farm Roastery) about his amazing coffee.

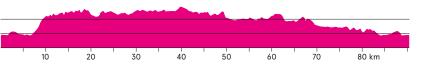


Jönköping Ironman 70.3

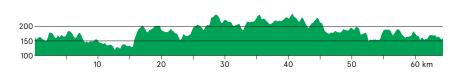

After climbing for a while, you'll follow winding roads through Tranås, Gripenberg, Linderås, and Hullaryd before you find yourself at the Krydderi Krokus in Adelöv, where you can sift through hundreds of spices. There's a cafe onsite too! When you continue, your uphill efforts will be rewarded with a fantastic descent.

Vättern Scarpe Landscape

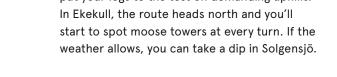
This countryside route winds past apple orchards along beautiful, (almost) car-free roads in the area known as Småland's Tuscany. Explore the organic farming area of Östra Vätterbranterna as you head towards the delightful town of Gränna, where you'll find coffee, ice cream, and Sweden's most famous hard candy - Polkagris. On the way home, take in the sights: open fields, dairy farms, and countless small red cottages.

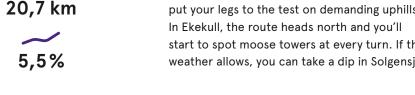

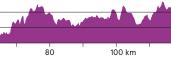
Småland's Mountain Stage

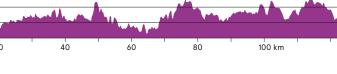
This is as close as we come to a Tour de France mountain stage in Småland. Pack extra food for energy and plenty to drink. This route will lead you through deep forests then straight up Tomtabacken, the highest point in southern Sweden. At the top, you'll be rewarded with some lactic acid in your legs and outstanding views. It's the perfect spot for a coffee break (BYO coffee!).











The Vidöstern Loop

An easy but lengthy route. The bike path heads south alongside Lake Vidöstern towards a lovely swimming spot at the lake's southern tip. When you continue on, keep an eye out for Vittaryd's beautiful whitewashed church before you hit a winding ridge that takes you further into the forest. Between Hånger och Värnamo, you'll cycle on an old, abandoned railway track.

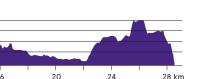

This route is for anyone who appreciates gravel paths, farm shops, cafes, and paradisal scenery. It starts with a ferry ride from Gränna to Visingsö. You can bring your bike on the ferry or rent one on the island (be sure to pre-order). The route is fairly easy and can be shortened at various places. Don't forget to take a fika break - and to stop for a swim. Be sure to bring a map too, since there is so much to discover!
